Keep the area treated clean and dry, and otherwise untreated until it is fully healed, which could take up to 4-6 weeks. Keep makeup off the treated area during this time.

Allow the area treated to dry and produce a slight scab/crust. After 24 hours a cortisone cream may be used to reduce excessive itching except around the eye area.

Do not apply any ointment to the treated area as they moisten and soften the crust of the skin. These products do not allow the pigment to continue to move to the surface of the skin.

Rinse the area three times a day with a sterile saline solution (OTC) to continue to “draw” pigment to the surface of the skin. After the third day, the discontinue the saline treatment.

The appearance of the skin may be slightly pink for several months following removal. Wait six weeks for attempting another removal. Up to three sessions can safely be performed to remove/lighten tattoos.
